GUITAR STUDIES

The guitar program at CSUS, chaired by Dr. Richard Savino, offers students the opportunity to pursue Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor Music, and Master of Music degrees in guitar and lute performance. In addition to taking specialized courses in guitar and lute studies, students also work directly with the numerous guests artists that periodically perform and teach at CSUS. In recent years these have included guitarists Manuel Barrueco, Eliot Fisk, David Starobin, David Tanenbaum, the LA Guitar Quartet, Deborah Morietti, Nicholas Goluses, Jose Maria Gallardo, the Castellani-Andriaccio Duo, the Elgart-Yates Duo, and lutenists Paul O'Dette, Nigel North, Hopkinson Smith, Ron McFarlane, and Konrad Junghanel.

Prior to acceptance into degree programs, students must pass an entrance audition. The following list includes suggested solo works. A movement from a work by Villa Lobos, Ponce, Brouwer or other contemporary composer
Master of Music
A suite by Bach or Weiss
An advanced sonata, fantasy or concerto by Sor, Giuliani or Paganini
