- 1717** Watteau, *The Music Party*
- 1729** Metastasio appointed court poet in Vienna
- 1740–1786** Reign of Frederick the Great of Prussia
1740 Maria Theresa of Austria crowned Holy Roman empress
- 1751** First volume of French *Encyclopédie* published
- 1759** Voltaire, *Candide*
1760–1820 Reign of George III of England
- 1762** Rousseau, *The Social Contract*
1765 Joseph II becomes Holy Roman emperor and co-ruler with Maria Theresa
- 1770** Gainsborough, *Blue Boy*
- 1774–1792** Reign of Louis XVI, king of France
1775–1783 American Revolution
1776 Declaration of Independence
- 1780** Death of Maria Theresa; Joseph II sole Hapsburg ruler
1781 Kant, *Critique of Pure Reason*
- 1788** Gibbon, *Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire*
1789–1794 French Revolution
