WHAT TO LISTEN FOR: Lyrical choral melody unifies 5-part rondo structure.

Changes in mode (major-minor) and texture (homorhythmic/

polyphonic).

Use of word painting—quicker in C section, and drawn out at end.

Emotional expressions of loss and acceptance of death.

Fourth Movement: M ssig bewegt (moderately agitated)

Text: Psalm 84

Form: Rondo (A-B-A'-C-A')

Character: Lilting triple meter, marked dolce (sweetly)
